Workshops with Earl



Artist **Earl W. Lehman's** year-long residency at Salt Springs began at the Celebration in September 2017, and some of you got to meet him that day.

Earl's paintings currently hang in the hallway in the Wheaton House and can be seen by appointment until May 5, 2018, when the house will again be open on weekends. They are for sale, and the proceeds will benefit both

the artist and the Friends.

As part of his residency, Earl will offer a number of classes this year, beginning with two **collage painting workshops on Sundays, March 11 and 18.**

Meet and create collage paintings with Earl. We ask that you begin collecting (and bring with you) *thin* interesting scraps of material—paper, cloth, plastic, tags from clothing, ticket stubs, advertising scraps—in various colors, shapes, and textures, real or implied.



No special skills or knowledge needed—Earl's here to guide us through the steps.

All ages welcome, but kids must be accompanied by an adult. Fee: \$10/person per class. In the Wheaton House.

We'll need the following supplies as well. We'll have some on hand, but if you can bring some as well, please do!

- Acrylic paints, brushes
- Colored pencils, colored pens, 6b pencils
- Quart containers for water
- Rags, paper towels
- Styrofoam egg cartons (for paint)
- 1" thick roll of blue tape
