Work Days for Flood Clean Up

Saturday & Sunday, July 29 & 30, 9 a.m.

Once again we have sustained some serious flood damage. The back parking lot and the floor of the Williams Pavilion are completely unusable at this point. Much of the gravel has been displaced and the ground is deeply rutted. Half of the road leading to the back parking lot was washed away and the drainage pipe exposed. We have barricaded it off. And of course there are rocks and debris strewn over large sections of the pavilion floor, some campsites, and the picnic areas along Fall Brook.

Come on one or both days this weekend to help us start cleaning up the park. We'll begin at 9 a.m. Come when you can and stay as long as you can.

Chores will include picking up branches and debris, shoveling up mud and gravel, resetting grills, and lots more. If you can, please bring shovels, rakes, pitchforks, buckets, and wheelbarrows. Plan on getting muddy - wear boots and bring gloves.
